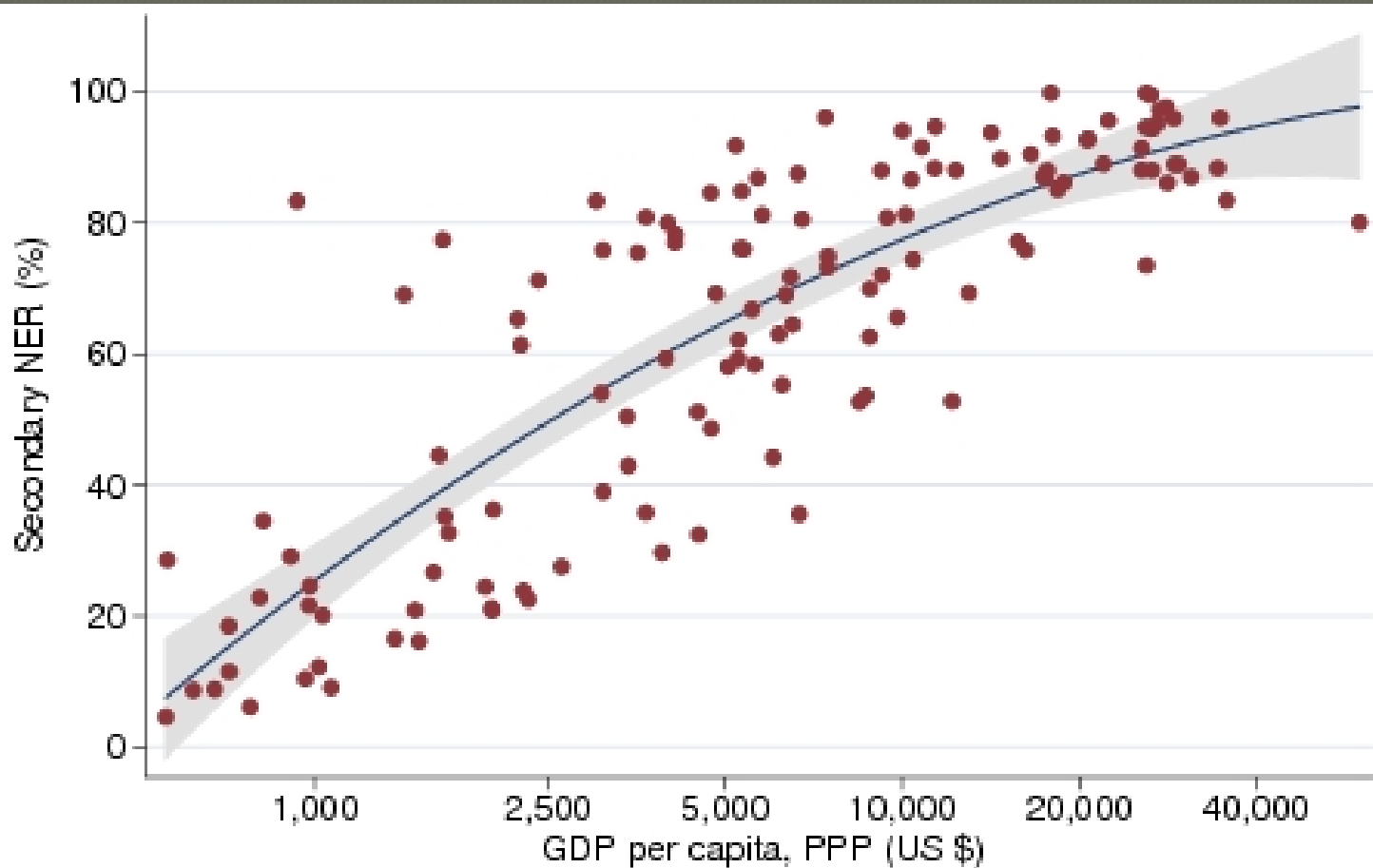


What is this program about?

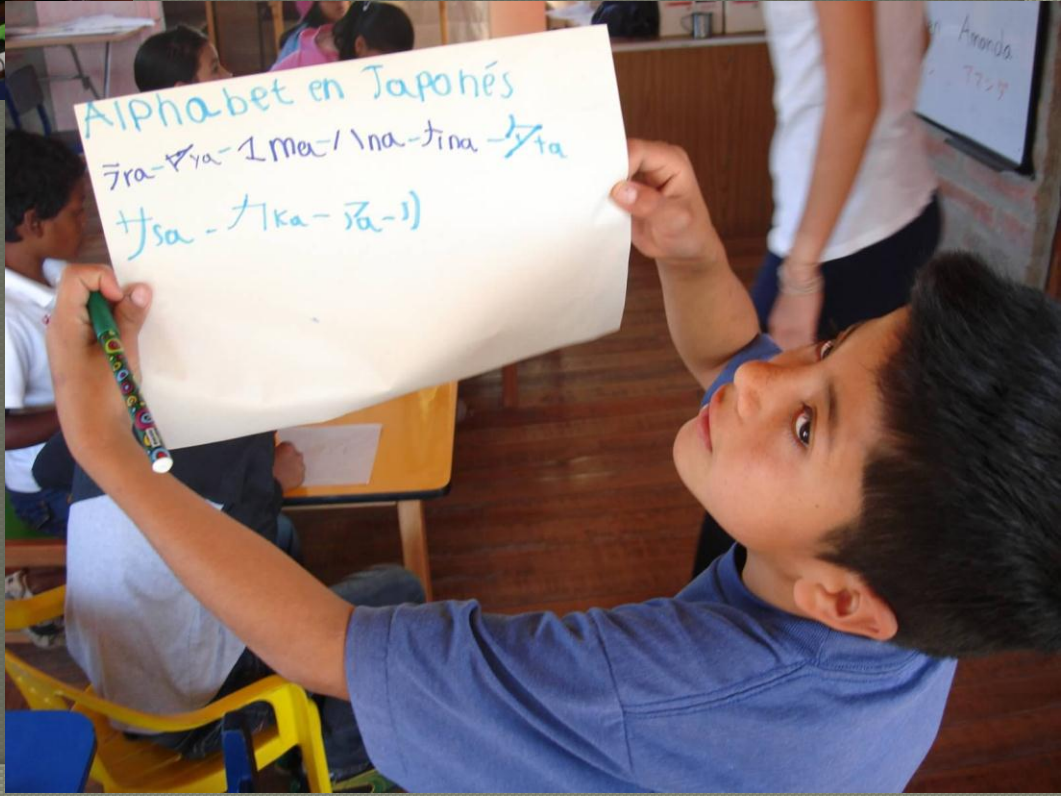
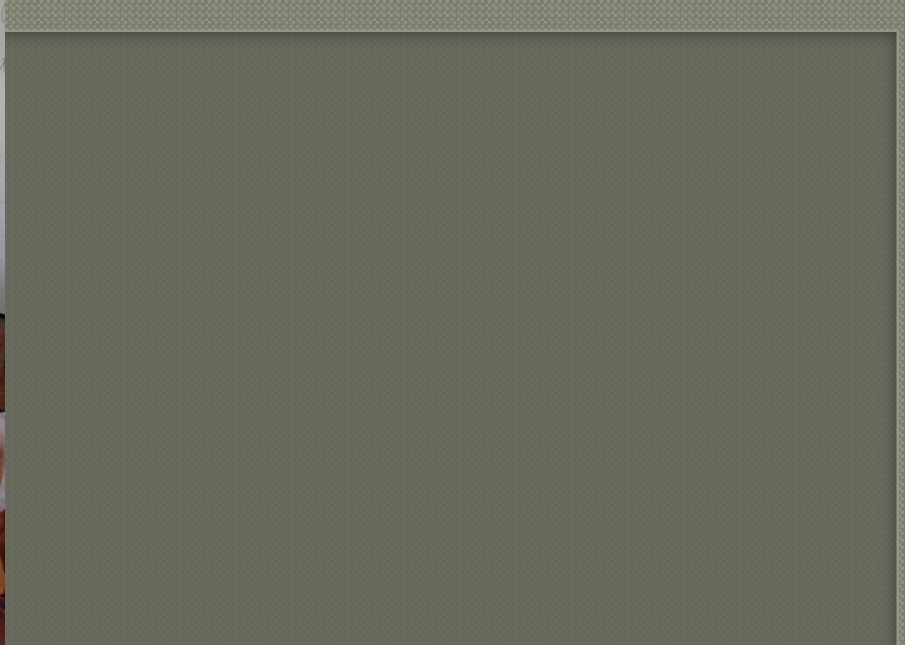
Children work on an environmental
