The host institution is a private language institute that offers Spanish language and culture classes to U.S. students, which makes it a great option for Spanish majors and minors. CEGRI offers personalized instruction, with average class sizes between 9 and 12 students in Language courses and up to 15 to 18 students in Culture courses. Also available are courses focusing on the rich culture of Spain and the region of Andalucía.
