Sydney Abroad Internships (ARTS2600)

Sydney Abroad Internship (ARTS2600) is a 6 credit point unit of study that includes a 120 hour internship and a rigorous calendar of academic components.

The unit is open exclusively to students studying at the University of Sydney on the Study Abroad Program. Students can complete this unit in either Semester 1 (March – June) or Semester 2 (July to November) of the University of Sydney's academic calendar.

As a Sydney Abroad intern you will undertake the following assessments tasks which contribute to a final grade that will appear on your University of Sydney transcript:

- 120 hours of industry placement
- 8 hours of professional development workshops
- 4 Blackboard discussions (200 words each)
- 4 reflective journals (400 words each)
- 1 final project report (2500 words)

Am I eligible to apply to the Sydney Abroad Internship program?

To be considered for Sydney Abroad Internships you need to:

- Be an applicant of the Study Abroad Program
- Satisfy all requirements of the Study Abroad Program
- Achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale, or 'B' or better on the ECTS grading scale
- Have completed at least 1.5 years of university study
